

A Summary of the Walks

All of the circular walks start and end at Cheswardine Parish Hall on Podmore Road, TF9 2FA

1) A 4 mile walk across fields, country lanes, along the canal and through woods which in springtime are full of wildflowers, including bluebells and wild garlic. Ideal for a lunchtime stop at the Wharf Tavern located on the canal at Bridge 55.

2) A 4 mile walk across fields and country lanes, including a lovely stretch of the canal. A short detour to Goldstone Hall* can offer afternoon tea in the garden in the summer.

3) A 4 mile walk along a good long stretch of the canal, with wonderful views of the Wrekin.

4) A 7.5 mile walk with superb views of Cheswardine Hall and across the valley. In the springtime bluebells and wild garlic are found along this route. A gruesome murder occurred at nearby Chipnall Mill in the winter of 1837/38!

5) A 4 mile walk offering views of Cheswardine Hall and St Swithun's church, including a delightful lane and small ponds.

6) A 3.5 mile easy walk along the road, returning through fields and Lawn Drumble. A perfect opportunity to visit the church and spot the cheeky gargoyle!

You can mix and match any of the walks, or combine them to make a longer walk. Try picking up the path north of Soudley if you want an even longer walk!

Cheswardine

Cheswardine is located about 5 miles from Market Drayton. The parish church, dedicated to St Swithun, overlooks Cheswardine from the hill at the top of the village. Cheswardine boasts two pubs in the village, The Red Lion and The Fox and Hounds. A third, The Wharf, is located on the canal at Bridge 55. There is also a Community Shop and a Parish Hall.

There is ample parking at the Parish Hall, TF9 2FA
